培群校友会章程

名称

一、 本会定名为“培群校友会”。

会址

二、 本会会址设于新加坡 319378 邮区，大巴窰六巷门牌三号。(若有任何更改，须由执行委员会通过并经由社团注册官加以批准。) 其他场所之活动必须获得有关当局之许可。

宗旨

三、 本会宗旨为：

- (1) 促进校友间之友谊。
- (2) 通过体育、社交及文化等活动，促进校友与母校在籍同学的情谊，团结与加强合作。
- (3) 以各种积极方式促进及展开有益于本会的社会福利活动。

会员

四、(1) 会员种类：

(i) 永久会员 (ii) 普通会员

(2) 任何校友，只要是奉公守法之公民，行为端正及愿意遵守本会章程者，不论其性别、年龄、种族及信仰，均可申请为本会会员。但在籍学生(中学、工艺学院)皆不得参与。

(3) 永久会员与普通会员都有选举权及被选举权，并在本章程下享有同等之权利。

五、只有年满十八岁之会员才有选举及被选举权。

六、任何申请入会者，须向本会秘书提呈其姓名及个人履历之入会申请书，寄交本会秘书。

(1) 任何新会员，须由会员提议附议，并将其姓名公布于本会会所之布告栏上，如果一星期内无人反对即正式成为本会会员。

若有会员反对，则由执行委员会作最后的决定。

(2) 每位新会员，于缴交入会费后，可获得本会章程壹份。

入会基金、月捐及其他会费

七、入会基金为每名五元正，须于入会后十日内缴交，否则执行委员会有权中止其会籍，退休者免交入会基金。

八、(1) 普通会员每月月捐二元正。

(2) 永久会员之会费，为两百元正，得一次缴清。退休者会费减半。

九、月捐须于每月首十日内交清，若有会员拖欠月捐或其他会费，本会财政应立即给予通知，若在四周内仍未缴清欠款者，本会会长可将其姓名，于本会会所之布告栏上公布并中止其会籍之权利。若连续三个月拖欠会费，其会员资格将自动被取消。

- 十、若有特殊用途而征收特别捐须由会员提出，并经会员大会通过。

会员大会与最高权利机构

- 十一、会员大会为本会最高权力机关，本会会长为会员大会的当然主席。
- 十二、常年会员大会订于每年十二月间举行。
- 十三、任何时候，凡经十名以上会员以书面要求或执行委员会之召集，本会会长必须召开会员特别大会，所要讨论之事项必须以书面提交给秘书。秘书须在两个月内处理并安排之。
- 十四、若执行委员会在两个月内不召集会员特别大会，提议者可在十天后进行召集会议，同时也将议程公布在会所的布告栏上。
- 十五、常年会员大会通知书，秘书须于大会召开前两星期寄发给会员，会员特别大会通知

书，则须最少十天寄发，大会议程前四天将之公布于本会会所之布告栏上。

- 十六、常年会员大会必须有下列事项：

- (1) 常年会务及财务报告。
- (2) 进行选举下届执行委员会。

- 十七、任何会员若有提案，欲列入大会议程内，必须于大会召开前一星期，以书面通知本会秘书。

- 十八、出席会员大会的最低法定人数为总会员人数的四分之一。

- 十九、会场若不足法定的最低人数时，会议得延迟半小时，届时若再不足法定人数，会议得依时召开，但不得对现有章程作任何修改或增删。

执行委员会

- 廿、执行委员会包括下列职位及委员，须于常年会员大会中选出。

- 会长 : 一名
副会长 : 一名
秘书 : 一名
副秘书长 : 一名
财政 : 一名
副财政 : 一名
普通执行委员 : 四名

会员大会选举过后，执行委员会有权推举不超过两名会员加入执行委员会，被推举出之委员与其他被直接选出之委员享有同等之职权。

- 廿一、所有上述职员及委员，必须在常年会员大会上，由一名会员提议及另一位会员附议，以简单的多数票选出。除正副财政外，其余均可连任，任期为二年。
- 廿二、选举可采用举手方式或绝大多数出席会员之同意而采用秘密投票方式。当票数相等时，主持会议之主席可多投一票。

廿三、执行委员会每两个月至少召开一次会议，并须于会议前七天通知全体执委。会长可随时于五日前，通知执行委员会召开会议。会议之法定人数为全体执委之半数。

廿四、任何执行委员在没有任何适当的理由下，连续三次缺席会议者，均作自动辞职论。执行委员会有权委任新执行委员代替之。其任期至下一届常年会员大会为止。若有任何更改需在两星期内通知社团注册官。

廿五、执行委员会的任务，在于组织及监督日常会务的进行，并对有关的事务作出决定。执行委员会进行会务时，不得作出违反会员大会的决策。

廿六、执行委员每月开支不得超过五百元。

执行委员会委员的职权

廿七、会长为所有会员大会及执行委员会会议的当然主席，并对外代表本会。

廿八、副会长的任务是协助会长并于会长缺席时，代替执行其职务。

廿九、正秘书负责保管本会财政事务以外的一切文件，并确保其正确性，且负责所有会员大会及执行委员会会议的记录，以及保管会员登记簿。

卅、秘书负责协助正秘书，并在秘书缺席时代替执行其职务。

卅一、正财政负责掌管本会的收入与开支款项，并负责所有的账簿和财政单据，每月现金支付不得超过一百元，所收现款超过一百元的款项，即须存入由执行委员会指定的本会银行账户。银行开支之支票，除财政签名外，亦得由会长或副会长或秘书签名方为有效。

卅二、副财政负责协助正财政并在正财政缺席时，代替执行其职务。

卅三、普通执行委员可被执行委员会委任其他职务，以便共同促进本会会务。

名誉会长

卅四、执行委员会有权邀请社会贤达为本会名誉会长，其任期由本会自行决定。

查账及财政年度

卅五、常年会员大会将选出二名非执行委员为查账，任期两年，不得连任。其任务为审查常年账目，以及向常年会员大会提呈报告。并依主席的指示，在其任内期间，审查任何时期的账目，并向执行委员会提呈报告。

卅六、本会的财政年度始于每年十月一日至第二年九月三十日。

信托人

卅七、若本会任何时候拥有任何不动产，则须委任信托人托管之。

卅八、信托人

(1) 人数不得超过四位或少过两位。

- (2) 必须从会员大会中选出。
- (3) 不经过会员大会许可或授权，不得变卖或抵押本会财产。

卅九、 信托人之辞职或罢免：

- (1) 信托人逝世，精神错乱，精神不健全。
- (2) 离开新加坡长达一年者。
- (3) 因不良行为而被判有罪或行为不适合继续担任者。
- (4) 自动辞职者。

四十、 有关罢免任何信托人之提案，或委任新信托人填补空缺之提案通告，须于会议举行前两星期公布于本会会所。大会的议决案必须提呈给社团注册官。

四十一、 本会拥有之不动产的地址、信托人姓名及较后的变动等等，均须呈报社团注册官。

贵宾到访

四十二、 凡是新加坡居民均被允许莅访本会会所，唯不得享有任何权利，且一年不得到会所超过六次，十四天内不可超过一次。

四十三、 本会须设有访客记录簿，以备记录宾客的姓名、到访日期及同行访问之会员加以签名。

禁例

四十四、 (1) 本会会所严禁一切赌博或贮藏赌具。同时，也严禁吸毒等行为及其他不良活动。

(2) 本会基金不得被用作替代会员支付法庭之一切罚款。

(3) 本会不得参与任何合法的职工会活动。

(4) 本会不得直接或间接影响或限制会员对物价进行控制以及要求提供回扣或折扣等商业活动。

- (5) 本会不得以本会、执行委员会、执行委员或会员的名称发行任何彩票。
- (6) 本会不得参与任何政治活动，亦不得利用本会基金与会所充作政治活动之用途。
- (7) 若未获得刑事调查组主任和有关部门的书面批准，本会不得向公众人士筹募任何基金。

修改章程

四十五、本会章程若有任何修改或增删，须由出席会员大会的会员中有一半以上同意通过，同时也预先获得社团注册官批准，始得生效。

章程的注释

四十六、若有任何事宜在本章程内尚未有明文规定，本会执行委员会有权作最后的决定。除非会员大会加以否定。

争论

四十七、若遇有任何争执，务须按照章程在特别会员大会中谋求解决。若双方无法解决争端，就得交给法庭处理。

解散

- 四十八、(1) 本会不得自行解散，除非获得到会的五分之三会员，在大会上一致通过，才能给予解散。
- (2) 若会解散获得通过，本会所负的一切合法债务，必须清还。若基金尚有剩余，则依会员大会之决定，捐给慈善机关。
- (3) 本会若决定解散，必须于七天内以书面通知社团注册官。



CONSTITUTION OF PEI CHUN OLD STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION

NAME

1. This Association shall be known as the "Pei Chun Old Students' Association" hereinafter referred to as the "Association".

PLACE OF BUSINESS

2. Its place of business shall be at "3, Lorong 6, Toa Payoh, Singapore 319378" or such other address as may subsequently be decided upon by the Committee and approved by the Registrar of Societies. The Association shall carry out its activities only in places and premises which have the prior written approval from the relevant authorities, where necessary.

OBJECTS

3. Its objects are:
 - a) to encourage friendly relationship amongst former students of Pei Chun Public School;
 - b) to promote co-operation amongst members through sporting, social and cultural activities; and
 - c) to give support, pecuniary and otherwise to any deserving project that is connected with the welfare of the Association.

MEMBERSHIP

4.
 - a) There shall be only two types of membership:
 - I) Life Membership and
 - II) Ordinary Membership.
 - b) Membership is open to all former students of Pei Chun Public School who are law-abiding Singapore Citizens of good character and who agree to abide by the Constitution of the Association, provided always that persons currently attending secondary schools, centralized

institutes or junior colleges shall not be admitted as members of the Association. There shall be no restriction on sex, race, age and religion.

- c) Both Life Members and Ordinary Members of the Association shall have the same right to vote and to hold office. They shall enjoy the same rights and privileges under the Constitution of the Association.
5. Only members who are above 18 years of age shall have the right to vote and to hold office in the Association.
6. A person wishing to join the Association as Life Member or Ordinary Member should submit his name and particulars to the Honorary Secretary on a prescribed form.
 - a) A new member must be proposed and seconded by existing members. His name will then be posted on the notice board in the Association's premises for one week at the end of which time he will be eligible for membership provided that there is no objection. In the event of objection

being raised the Committee will decide on the matter.

- b) A copy of the Constitution of the Association shall be furnished to every approved member upon payment of the entrance Fee.

ENTRANCE FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND OTHER DUES

7. An entrance fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for either life Membership or ordinary Membership is payable within ten days of election to membership, in default of which membership may be cancelled by order of the Committee. For retirees, the entrance fee is waived.
8. Subscriptions are payable as follows:
 - a) Life Membership - A one-time Payment of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).
 - b) Ordinary Membership - Two Dollars (\$2.00) per month. For retirees, the monthly subscription is reduced by half.
9. Subscriptions for Life Membership are payable within

ten days of election to membership. Monthly subscriptions for Ordinary Members are payable in advance within ten days of the first of the month. If a member falls into arrears with his subscription or other dues he shall be informed immediately by the Honorary Treasurer. If he fails to settle his arrears within four weeks of their becoming due, the President may order that his name be posted on the Association's notice board and that he be denied the privileges of membership until he settles his account. If he falls into arrears for more than 3 months' dues he will automatically cease to be a member.

10. Any additional fund required for particular purposes may only be raised from Members with the consent of the General Meeting of the members.

SUPREME AUTHORITY AND GENERAL MEETINGS

11. The supreme authority of the Association is vested in a General Meeting of the members presided over by the President.

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12. An Annual General Meeting shall be held in December every year.

13. At other times an Extraordinary General Meeting must be called by the President on the request in writing of ten or more voting members and may be called at any time by order of the Committee. The notice in writing shall be given to the Honorary Secretary setting forth the business that is to be transacted. The Extraordinary General Meeting shall be convened within two months from receiving this request to convene the Extraordinary General Meeting.

14. If the Committee does not act within two months after the date of the receipt of the written request proceed to convene an Extraordinary General Meeting, the members who requested for the Extraordinary General Meeting may convene the Extraordinary General Meeting by giving 10 days' notice in voting members setting forth the business to be transacted and simultaneously posting the agenda on the Association's notice board.

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15. At least two weeks' notice shall be given of an Annual General Meeting and at least ten days' notice of an Extraordinary General Meeting. Notice of meeting stating the date, time and place of the meeting shall be sent by the Honorary Secretary to all voting members. The particulars of the agenda shall be posted on the Association's notice board four days in advance of the meeting.
 16. The following points will be considered at the Annual General Meeting:
 - a) The previous financial year's accounts and annual report of the Committee.
 - b) Where applicable, the election of office-bearers and Honorary Auditors for the following term.
 17. Any member who wishes to place an item on the agenda of a General Meeting may do so provided he gives notice to the Honorary Secretary one week before the meeting is due to be held.
 18. At least one-quarter of the total voting membership of the Association present at a General Meeting shall form a quorum.

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19. In the event of there being no quorum at the commencement of a General Meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned for half an hour and should the number then present be insufficient to form a quorum, those present shall be considered a quorum, but they shall have no power to amend any of the existing Rules.

MANAGEMENT AND COMMITTEE

20. The administration of the Association shall be entrusted to a Committee consisting of the following to be elected at each alternate Annual General Meeting:
 - A President
 - A Vice President
 - An Honorary Secretary
 - An Honorary Assistant Secretary
 - An Honorary Treasurer
 - An Honorary Assistant Treasurer
 - Four ordinary Committee Members
- The Committee shall have the power to co-opt after the election, not more than two voting members to

ten days of election to membership. Monthly subscriptions for Ordinary Members are payable in advance within ten days of the first of the month. If a member falls into arrears with his subscription or other dues he shall be informed immediately by the Honorary Treasurer. If he fails to settle his arrears within four weeks of their becoming due, the President may order that his name be posted on the Association's notice board and that he be denied the privileges of membership until he settles his account. If he falls into arrears for more than 3 months' dues he will automatically cease to be a member.

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a term of two years only and shall not be re-elected for a consecutive term. They:

- a) will be required to audit each year's accounts and present a report upon them to the Annual General Meeting.
- b) may be required by the President to audit the Association's accounts for any period within their tenure of office at any date and make a report to the Committee.

36. The financial year shall be from 1st day of October to 30th day of September.

TRUSTEES

37. If the Association at any time acquires any immovable property, such property shall be vested in trustees subject to a declaration of trust.

38. The trustees of the Association shall:

- a) not be more than four and not less than two in number.
- b) be elected by a General Meeting of Members.

c) not effect any sale or mortgage of property without the prior approval of the General Meeting of Members.

39. The office of the trustee shall be vacated:

- a) If the trustee dies or becomes a lunatic or of unsound mind.
- b) If he is absent from the Republic of Singapore for a period of more than one year.
- c) If he is guilty of misconduct of such a kind as to render it undesirable that he continues as a trustee.
- d) If he submits notice of resignation from his trusteeship.

40. Notice of any proposal to remove a trustee from his trusteeship or to appoint a new trustee to fill a vacancy must be given by posting it on the notice board in the Association's premises at least two weeks before the General Meeting at which the proposal is to be discussed. The result of such General Meeting shall then be notified to the Registrar of Societies.

41. The addresses of immovable properties, names of

name of the Association or its office-bearers, Committee or members, unless with the prior approval of the relevant authorities.

- f) The Association shall not indulge in any political activities or allow its funds and/or premises to be used for political purposes.
- g) The Association shall not raise funds from the public for whatever purpose without the prior approval in writing of the Director, Criminal Investigation Department and other relevant authorities.

AMENDMENTS TO RULES

- 45. No alteration or addition/deletion to these Rules shall be made except at a General Meeting and with the consent of more than one-half of the voting members present at the General Meeting, and they shall not come into force without the prior sanction of the Registrar of Societies.

INTERPRETATION

- 46. In the event of any question or matter arising out of any point which is not expressly provided for in the Rules the Committee shall have the power to use their own discretion. The decision of the Committee shall be final unless it is reversed at a General Meeting of Members.

DISPUTES

- 47. In the event of any dispute arising amongst members, they shall attempt to resolve the matter at an Extraordinary General Meeting in accordance with the Rules in the Constitution. Should the members fail to resolve the matter, they may bring the matter to a court of law for settlement.

DISSOLUTION

- 48. a) The Association shall not be dissolved, except with the consent of not less than 3/5 of the total voting membership of the Association for the time

trustees and any subsequent change must be notified to the Registrar of Societies.

VISITORS AND GUESTS

42. Residents in Singapore may be admitted into the premises of the Association but they shall not be admitted to the privileges of the Association nor shall they be admitted into the premises more than six times in a calendar year. These visits are to be confined to not more than once in 14 days.
43. A Visitor's book shall be kept, in which shall be entered the names of all visitors and guests, together with the signatures and names of the members nominating them and the dates of their visits. No person shall be a visitor or guest till his name has been entered in this book.

PROHIBITIONS

44. a) Gambling of any kind, whether for stakes or not is forbidden on the Association's premises. The

introduction of materials for gambling or drug taking and of bad characters into the premises is prohibited.

- b) The funds of the Association shall not be used to pay the fine of members who have been convicted in Court.
- c) The Association shall not engage in any trade union activities as defined in any Written law relating to trade unions for the time being in force in Singapore.
- d) The Association shall not attempt to restrict or interfere with trade or make directly or indirectly any recommendation to any arrangement with its members which has the purpose or is likely to have the effect of fixing or controlling the price or any discount allowance or rebate relating to any goods or services which adversely affect consumer interests.
- e) The Association shall not hold any lottery, whether confined to its members or not, in the

being resident in Singapore expressed, either in person or by proxy, at a General Meeting convened for the purpose.

- b) In the event of the Association being dissolved as provided above, all debts and liabilities legally incurred on behalf of the Association shall be fully discharged, and the remaining funds will be donated to charitable organizations as decided on at the General Meeting.
- c) A Certificate of Dissolution shall be given within 7 days of the dissolution to the Registrar of Societies.

AMENDMENTS TO RULES OF CONSTITUTION


